It has been lovely to see so many of you able to join us for different events over the school year. We thoroughly enjoy having you in school, as do the children. In order to make any future events as successful as they have been previously, we would like to make you aware that from now on, pupils are not permitted to leave school early unless for a medical appointment or a special circumstance that staff are aware of. Parents will be asked to collect their child(ren) at the end of the school day from the playground at 3.20pm. This will be the same protocol for watching any performances, special assemblies, parents' consultations or special events. Thanks for your cooperation with this.

You may have noticed that we have a new wall in place in the school entrance hall. Pupils and parents will no longer be able to access the main school corridor/school building, without a member of staff allowing them to. This makes our school a more secure and safe site and we are very pleased with the overall impact of this. If you are attending a celebration assembly on a Friday morning, please arrive at school for 8.50am when a member of the team will allow parents access to the hall at the same time.



Children who arrive to school late, will be kept in the office area until a member of the office team releases the door to take them up to class- this can be quite daunting for our children as no one likes to arrive into a situation late.
